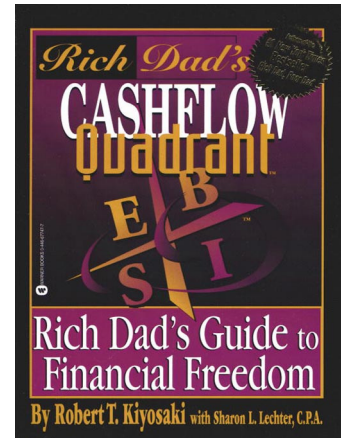


# Financial Math Book Review Requirements

Due ON OR BEFORE (but not after) **Thursday, August 27<sup>th</sup>**.  
NO exceptions. (Early is better.)

It is worth 100 points.

The book is “**Cashflow: Rich Dad's Guide to Financial Freedom**” by Robert T. Kiyosaki.  
(It is NICE, but NOT NECESSARY to have read the first book “Rich Dad, Poor Dad.”)



You can borrow or buy, paper or CD, listen or read. I just want the information in your head! (So do NOT “wing it” or cut & copy from the internet.)

## **The Review must:**

- convince me that you actually read the book.
- have acceptable grammar and spelling.
- be at least 3 full pages in length. (So “top of the fourth.”)
- be double spaced.
- have 14 point, Arial or Times New Roman font, 1 inch margins.
- include the purpose of the book (often found in the Preface or Foreword).
- include a synopsis of the book. (What's it about? What's the point?)
- include YOUR opinion of whether the author accomplished their purpose.
- include YOUR opinion of the book in general.
- include something you liked AND something you hated about the book.
- include how this book applies to YOU and YOUR finances.

The Review MAY include quotes, but EXCESSIVE quotes will count off UNLESS the paper is lengthened to compensate.

Do NOT include graphics UNLESS appropriate length is added to your paper.
